## *Patriot's Day Storm*

### Presidential Declaration, FEMA–1693–DR

Since Maine has been approved with a Presidential Declaration for the Patriot's Day storm, and Somerset County has been included in the declaration, it is expected that there will be a lot of applicant interest to receive Public Assistance for the Pubic damage that occurred. To help the town's complete applications, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), the Maine Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) and the Somerset County Emergency Management Agency (STEMA) is providing an applicant briefing and kick-off meeting, and have scheduled a session for its towns.
